What is the PSAT/NMSQT?

This is an assessment designed to measure reading, writing and language, and math skills developed over many years, both in and out of school. This year the assessment will be given digitally.

What are the reasons I should take the PSAT/NMSQT?

- Scholarship Opportunities: Juniors may be eligible for the National Merit Scholarship program.
- SAT Advantage: PSAT/NMSQT and the SAT have the same format and evaluate the same skills.
- Feedback on Strengths and Weaknesses: Students receive feedback on how ready they are for college and access to tools that help them improve.
- AP Potential™: PSAT/NMSQT scores inform stakeholders how likely students are to succeed in AP courses and Exams.
- Online College Planning: Free access to My College QuickStart™-includes an interactive score report, a personality test, major and career suggestions, and a starter list of colleges.

How can I prepare for the PSAT/NMSQT?

What should I do if I need testing accommodations?

- ✓ An approved calculator - a graphing calculator is built into the testing platform but you can bring your own. Bring extra batteries because the school cannot provide batteries.
