Students have the privilege of driving personal vehicles to school. Each vehicle **MUST** be registered and a parking permit purchased at a cost of \$40.00 PER YEAR. Price will decrease to \$20.00 for second semester.

Students must abide by the following rules in order to maintain their parking privileges:

1. Students must pass five (5) classes and have no more than five (5) unexcused absences, in order to purchase a permit. The permit will be suspended after the first semester if the above mentioned criteria have not been met.
2. The student must present a copy of his/her driver's license at the time of permit purchase.
3. A student may purchase a permit only if ALL school debts have been cleared.
4. All vehicles parked on the school grounds must be registered with the school and **MUST DISPLAY A CURRENT PERMIT. PERMIT TO BE DISPLAYED ON REAR DRIVER'S WINDOW – NO BACK IN PARKING IS ALLOWED.**
5. Parking is strictly limited to the student parking area; students are not permitted to park in the Faculty parking areas. ***NO ONE is allowed to park in the fire lanes – students or faculty.***
6. All students must be licensed and covered by automobile insurance. The school is not responsible for any damage or loss suffered to the vehicle or its contents. It is strongly recommended that students do not leave valuables in their vehicles.
7. Students may not loiter or have visitation in the parking lot without permission.
8. There will be no speeding, over five (5) miles per hour, or any form of reckless driving on school grounds such as jumping the curb, scratching or driving over medians.
9. Parking permits are NON-TRANSFERRABLE between students; any violation will result in both parties losing their permits for one semester.
10. Student vehicles may be subject to search if there are reasonable grounds to believe that drugs, alcohol, weapons, stolen property or other contraband might be present in that vehicle.
11. Parking regulations are strictly enforced. It is considered a privilege to park on school grounds. Suspension of driving privileges, towing of vehicles (at OWNER'S EXPENSE) and/or other suspension from suspension from school may result when violators of regulations occur.
